

NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS OF BANDERA COUNTY ABNORMAL DROUGHT RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

The Bandera County River Authority And Groundwater District has moved the County to Abnormally Dry Drought Restrictions. The move was based on the current groundwater levels and the rainfall deficit.

Below is a comprehensive breakdown of the current drought restrictions for well owners in effect as of August 08, 2017:

The following drought restrictions and any subsequent enforcement actions not only apply to all permit holders and public water suppliers but to anyone who utilizes water from a public water supply system or any District permit holder in the County.


- A. Water permit users shall limit irrigation, including the irrigation of landscaped areas and turf, to the hours after 6:00 PM and before 8 AM to reduce water losses due to evaporation.
- B. The following uses of water are defined as non-essential and shall be prohibited:
- 1. Washing down any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, or other hard-surfaced areas.
- 2. Washing down buildings or structures for purposes other than immediate fire protection.
- 3. Failure to repair a controllable leak within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such a leak.
