The Bandera County River Authority And Groundwater District has moved the County to NO Drought Restrictions. The move was based on the current groundwater levels and the rainfall deficit.

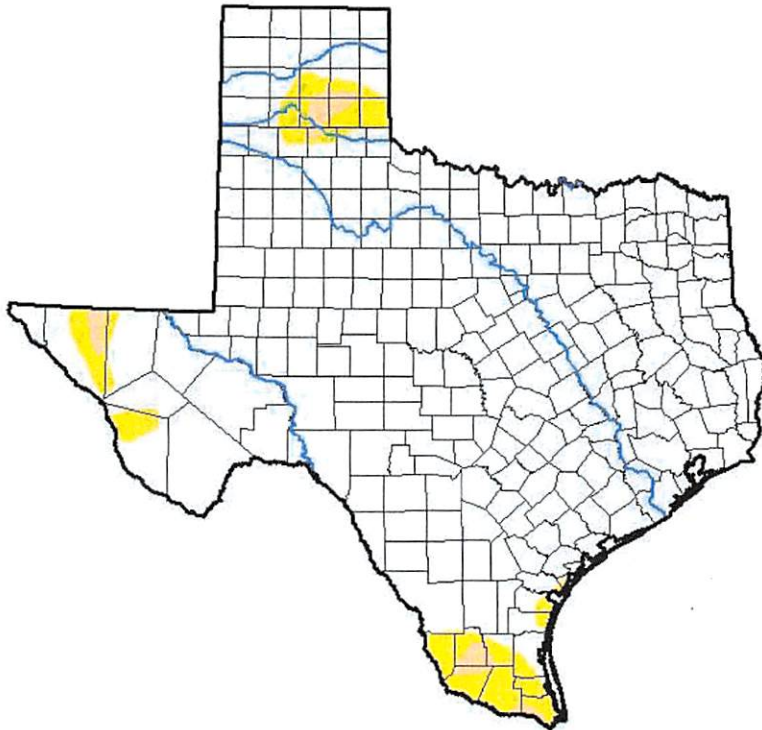
