Effective November 10, 2022

Definition	Fee
Registered Well – A well that meets the requirements for exemption from permitting, and is assigned a registered well number and registered by the district.	\$500
Permitted Well – A well that does not meet the requirements for exemption from permitting, is assigned a permitted well number, and permitted by the district.	\$1,500
Injection Well – A well that is utilized to inject or flow fluids into a subsurface formation.	\$1,500
Monitoring Well – A well that is constructed to measure or monitor the water level, quality and/or movement of water beneath the surface of the ground.	\$1,500
Observation Well – A water well for observing water level changes during an aquifer test.	\$1,500
Test Well – An artificial excavation of a well created from drilling, boring, or coring for the exploration for groundwater and/or testing aquifer conditions for pump tests.	\$1,500
